<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students must wear a WCA lanyard and ID badge around their neck and over their clothing at all times. • The following are not permitted at Wright Christian Academy: visible tattoos, body piercing other than ears, distracting jewelry or accessories. • Girl hair—Clean, groomed, and out of the eyes. Hair should not be excessively long or short, distracting, or draw excessive attention. No non-recognizable human hair color. • Boy hair—Clean, groomed, and out of the eyes. Hair should not be excessively long or short, distracting or draw excessive attention. No non-recognizable human hair color. • No clothing is to be excessively tight fitting, excessively baggy, have holes, or excessive wear. • Pants, shorts, and skirts must be worn at the waist. • Polo and Oxford shirts are to be tucked in. No low necklines or bare midriffs. • Makeup is permitted for girls only. If makeup is worn, it should be modest, not distracting, and in good taste. No black lipstick. • Ear pods, buds, and headphones are not to be worn except when permitted for educational purposes. • Home Games – With coach’s permission athletes may wear their athletic jersey with dress code pants/shorts/skirt.
